



How Close to 100?

This is a fun activity sheet for adults and children. Players work together to fill as many of the 100 squares as possible. Use the attached grid or make you own.

Supplies:

A 10 X 10 grid (*example attached*)
colored pencils (*regular pencils are acceptable*)
2 dice

Play:

Player 1 rolls 2 dice.

Multiply the 2 numbers on the dice, then color a matrix of squares indicated by the dice. After coloring the grid, write the equation in the spaces below the grid. For example, if a player rolled a 3 and a 4, color a rectangle 3 square wide by 4 squares long, then write $3 \times 4 = 12$ in the space below the grid.

Each player repeats this play. All players work together to fill as many squares as possible.

Modification: Do addition instead of multiplication. So if you roll a 3 and 4, you color 7 squares, and write $3+4 = 7$ in the space below the grid.
